

What to Expect

We ask that you bring all your gear to the trailhead between 2-5 p.m. the day before your departure day, so we can have everything packed and ready to go in the morning to ensure an early start.

No food or drinks will be provided for drop services, so please eat breakfast and pack a lunch before you show up on departure day.

If you will be riding instead of walking, we will provide you with a horse and all necessary tack and saddle bags for your trip into the South Fork of the Flathead River. You must limit the extra gear for the ride in on the horse to 15 lbs max (i.e. water bottle, sack lunch, rain gear).

The cost for riding animals is \$300 if going into the Gordon Creek confluence and \$325 if going into the Youngs/Danaher Creek confluence.

To simplify pricing we now charge per pound for gear being packed in. The cost is \$3.00 per/lb for trips going down Gordon Creek and \$3.25 per/lb for trips going down Youngs Creek. As always, we do not have any additional fees for packers or wranglers. Please have all loose items packed in duffel bags, boxes, coolers, etc. with no pack in excess of 75lbs and no traditional coolers larger than 70 quarts or extreme coolers (Yeti, RTIC, Grizzly) larger than 65 quart.

No items over 75lbs will be taken except for flexible items such as rafts that can be draped over a mule.

For trips to the Gordon Creek Confluence we will depart from the Owl Creek Packer Camp, Condon, MT. For trips going to the confluence of Youngs/Danaher confluence we will depart from the Pyramid Trailhead near Seeley Lake.

Deposit Policy:

A deposit of 50% will book the particular trip you want. The remainder of the 50% deposit is due the day you meet the packers/guides at the trailhead before your trip. Once the packers have weighed each item the remaining balance is due cash, credit card, or check are acceptable forms of payment.

Payment Policy:

If paying with a credit card there will be a 3% processing fee. Cash and check are also acceptable forms of payment. Checks being made out to CHEFF LEGACY OUTFITTERS

Cancellation Policy:

Deposits are nonrefundable. This space is held for you, and this means turning others away. Deposits are transferable if you have someone else to take your place. In the event of Forest Fires, USFS closures, or other natural disasters, any remaining deposits may be held for a future reservation within 2 years.
